Kleanza will hold all levels of management accountable for providing a safe work environment and enforcing safe work procedures and practices. We will also ensure timely follow-up to safety incidents.


Kleanza will hold all employees and contractors accountable for following safe work procedures and reporting unsafe acts and safety incidents.
